What we offer

Breizoz offers a wedding with a difference. You can have your ceremony and reception in the same venue. Make it as casual or formal as you like and select from our varied menus.

We can help you with services such as celebrants, photographers, florists and musicians. Please ask for a list of our recommended services.

THE FACILITIES

Breizoz is unique as a venue as it used to be the Williamstown Seaman's mission and has a small chapel in the rear. Many people have been married at this chapel in its days as a formal chapel. Nowadays the chapel is not set up as a traditional church allowing you versatility to design your ceremony.

It is also not too large and is ideal for groups of 15-90. Most importantly you can have your ceremony and reception in the same venue.



MENU OPTIONS

There are two main menu options: the Traditional French Menu or the Cocktail party menu.

FRENCH MENU

The French general menu begins with an aperitif with finger food. The meal consists of three courses of typical French cuisine with options for vegetarians, and finishing with coffee. There is a variety of menu options to choose from.

The room hire fee for the chapel is \$200. If you need to use the restaurant as well (this is necessary for numbers greater than 55 - Maximum 75) then the hire is \$400 for the whole facility.

The French menu is \$75 per person including champagne, beer, wine and soft drink with the meal and coffee. You will need to place a tab after the coffee has been served. We can provide an estimate of your tab for you.

THE COCKTAIL PARTY

The room hire is \$200 which includes a staffed bar, setup and the management of the wedding party.

The menu includes a simple selection of savoury finger food. Generally the wedding cake is served as dessert. We can make this too—have a look at the selection of cakes on our website.

This party is suitable for smaller a small informal wedding.

The costs of a cocktail party menu are:

- \$43 per person for a 3.5 hour party
- \$50 per person for a 4.5 hour party

This means that the tab covers your food and standard drinks for this time and a tab will be placed after the time limit.. This works well if you are having a band or DJ later.

How many can we cater for?

- If you want your wedding and reception in the chapel –sit down 50 maximum, cocktail party 85 maximum
- If you want to use the restaurant for the meal – maximum 75 seated.
